Under NO circumstances will dogs be allowed to disturb the resting stock or interfere from outside the arena with another dog's performance in the arena. Any dogs aggressive to persons or stock will be removed. (See Chapter 1, Section 20 of the *American Kennel Club Herding Regulations*.)

**Lunch** will be available on site only if you complete and return the pre-ordered lunch form. Please bring your chairs, shade, etc. Bottled water and soda will be for sale. All AKC Rules regarding conduct will be strictly enforced.
